FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE

We no longer need to solicit pre-registrations to facilitate our weekend Mass schedule in the PCA! This means that anyone can now attend Mass anywhere at any time in our PCA. Please be aware that Bishop Lucia has also announced the following: *"With the lifting of restrictions, I will discontinue in the Diocese of Syracuse the dispensation from Sunday Mass beginning on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on Sunday, June 6th. It should be noted as well that anyone who is frail or at risk due to advanced age or medical conditions is always excused from this obligation. Caregivers, too, may have to use prudential judgement about attendance at Mass carefully considering the risk factors involved."* Here is a brief summary of what is contained in new COVID protocols for our diocese:

- Masks and social distancing are no longer required for **fully vaccinated people**.
- All who prefer to continue wearing facial covering and social distancing are free to do so.
- It is no longer necessary to block off every other pew.
- **Please help maintain physical distance in the pews around those who are still required to wear masks/engage in social distancing and for those who may be fully vaccinated but wish to continue to follow distancing practices.**
- Parishes are no longer required to pre-register attendees for Mass.
- Parishes are no longer required to check-in people as they arrive.
- The Offertory Procession with the gifts of the bread and wine can resume.
- Offertory collections with baskets may be resumed by ushers.

Please be respectful and patient with your neighbor in the pews, as this transition will be felt by all. St. Joan of Arc, St. Bernard, St. Mary, and St. Joseph, pray for us!
