All teens in high school are invited to join our Route20Catholic Confirmation Preparation Program for our next session on Sunday, October 17th at 12:15pm in the St. Mary's Church Hall. Our PCA recently developed a new curriculum for our Confirmation Prep that will involve guest lecturers at each session with extended Q & A, so our teens have plenty of time to ask questions and go deeper in their faith. The lecturers are typically lay people from our parishes who work in higher education at our local colleges and universities. Remember that in order for your teen to be eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, they must attend 90 percent of the sessions being offered each year.
