This is a big weekend for the Diocese of Syracuse because we will be celebrating the ordination to the priesthood of Rev. Mr. Malachi Clark. His ordination was postponed from the first weekend of June due to COVID-19, so we are overjoyed to finally be able to ordain this man to the priesthood of Jesus Christ. Liturgical Ministers Update

Although we had hoped to resume our typical Liturgical Ministers schedule the weekend of August 22/23, Father Hage has decided to wait until the new Mass schedule is published for all four parishes in the PCA. That way, there will not be any confusion caused by publishing one Liturgical Ministers calendar and then another within a couple of weeks for the same weekends. Thank you for your patience. Once we receive the new Mass schedule from the bishop's office, we will begin our Liturgical Ministers schedule immediately.

COVID-19 Update

All travelers entering New York from a state with a positive test rate higher than 10 per 100,000 residents, or higher than a 10% test positivity rate, over a seven day rolling average, will be required to quarantine for a period of 14 days consistent with Department of Health regulations for quarantine. ***If you have recently traveled to any restricted state, please do not come to Mass until 14 days after your return.*** If you know of anyone who has traveled to a restricted state, please encourage them to join us by way of livestream until their quarantine is completed.

Monday Night Lights!

Father Hage will be hearing confessions on a weekly basis every Monday night from 5pm to 6pm at St. Mary's. Confessions will be heard at the entryway of the church, so people can stand outside in the fresh air while making their confession. Father Hage will be seated at a safe distance of six feet away inside the narthex of the church. Please wear a mask when you come to confession.

We are taking walk-ins at all of our daily Masses Monday through Thursday. The typical Tuesday 8am daily Mass at St. Joan's has resumed.
