Our New Bishop's Ordination—Parish Reps!

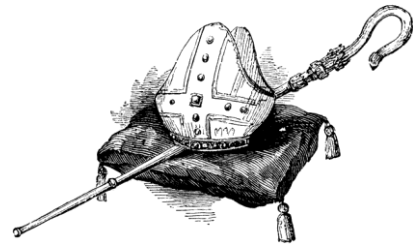

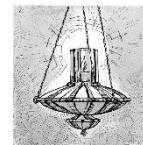
