FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE

This weekend, we remember in a special way all of the women and men religious who have had a positive impact on our lives. Immediately, Sister Margaret comes to mind from my own childhood. She was my elementary school principal who faithfully exuded the kindness, warmth, love, and mercy that flows from the heart of Christ. We pray in a special way today for an increase of vocations to religious life, especially from among our young women in the parish. In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted a day of prayer for women and men in consecrated life. This celebration is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2. This Feast is also known as Candlemas Day; the day on which candles are blessed symbolizing Christ who is the light of the world. So, too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ to all peoples. The celebration of World Day for Consecrated Life is transferred to the following Sunday in order to highlight the gift of consecrated persons for the whole Church. I would also like to share with you this prayer for consecrated persons:

God our Father, we thank you for calling men and women to serve in your Son's Kingdom as sisters, brothers, religious priests, consecrated virgins, and hermits, as well as members of Secular Institutes. Renew their knowledge and love of you, and send your Holy Spirit to help them respond generously and courageously to your will.
