I can't believe Lent is a little over two weeks away. I must admit that I deeply cherish the holy season of Lent more than any other. With the approval of the Pastoral Council and the support of the Altar Rosary Society, I have decided to launch a new Lenten initiative in our parishes this year. I have decided to have the Blessed Sacrament exposed in the monstrance every Wednesday during Lent from 9:30am to 9pm at St. Mary's. That's right, every Wednesday during Lent parishioners will have the opportunity to visit the church anytime during the day or night to visit our Eucharistic Lord. The reason for doing this is quite simple. I believe that Eucharistic Adoration can be a tremendous source of grace, blessing, and renewal for any parish community. There is something about silent Eucharistic Adoration that not only changes minds, but also changes hearts. The special intention we will be offering as a community when we come before the Eucharistic Lord will be the return of our families, friends, and loved ones who may be away from the practice of their faith. We will be praying for renewal in their lives as well as in our own. I am confident that the graces from this Lenten project will be abundant. We will have a sign-up sheet available the first weekend of Lent for those who would like to be guardians of the Eucharist while it is exposed. I will also be challenging all in the parish the first weekend of Lent to spend 15 minutes in front of the exposed Blessed Sacrament every Wednesday during Lent. Just 15 minutes can and will make all the difference. Again, you will be able to visit anytime day or night on Wednesdays. When you visit, you will come into a completely silent church where you can personally converse with the Lord, and listen in peace. Please join me in this privileged opportunity.
