I would like to invite all parishioners to attend the Parish Holy Hour that will take place this Wednesday, February 13 at 7pm at St. Mary's Church. **I will be offering the Holy Hour with the special intention of making reparation for the passage of the new abortion law in New York State** signed on January 22 (the Anniversary of Roe vs. Wade). The passage of this Reproductive Health Act is extremely disturbing, and should unsettle us to take action. We must renew our resolve to pray always for the protection of all human life from the moment of conception until natural death, especially here in our own state. We must also take action by advocating for change. I would like to do a letter-writing campaign to all of our state assemblypersons and senators in order to make our voices heard. If anyone reading this would like to coordinate/organize this letter-writing campaign, please speak with me after Mass. We must not underestimate what this new Reproductive Health Act means for the safety of so many of our unborn children. Let's be a voice for the voiceless.
