As we conclude this National Migration Week 2019, I would like to share with you a Prayer for Migrants and Refugees. I would also encourage you to visit justiceformigrants.org.

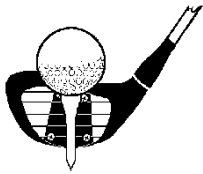
