Know that you will be in my prayers in a very special way during this week. I always make a big part of my annual retreat special prayers for the communities I serve. I will ask God to continue to pour his blessing out upon our communities, to renew us in his love, his mercy, and his grace. I will pray for all of our parishioners who are suffering through a particular hardship at this time. I will also pray for those in our communities who may be away from their faith; that they might return home. I pray for you with a heart full of gratitude that the Lord has sent me to serve two wonderful parishes as well as the students at Colgate. Mary Immaculate and Saint Joan of Arc, pray for us!
