**FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE**

I can't believe next weekend is our St. Mary's Golf tournament! As of now, we have met our minimum goal for registered teams. We have over 16 teams currently registered! There are more teams who have verbally committed, but have not yet registered. The registration deadline is this weekend, so please register today. We have also come close to reaching our capacity for the "dinner only option" persons. This is truly amazing! At this point, we expect to see around 80 people at the clubhouse next Saturday night. I am so grateful to all in the parish who will be participating and showing their support!

I also have wonderful news about the HOPE Appeal! Our goal at St. Mary's is \$14,834. So far, 48 out of 151 registered households have given. We have raised in one month's time \$14,632, which means that this week we will have completed our parish goal! This is a great accomplishment for our parish communities, and has already been noticed by the diocesan administration in Syracuse. What a blessing! Thank you to all for your wonderful and awe-inspiring generosity. You have risen to the challenge I offered at the beginning of the month in an outstanding way. God bless you all! St. Joan's is also making historic progress in their goal as well. Our goal at St. Joan's is \$6,720. So far, 19 out of 50 households have given. We have raised in one month's time \$4,664, which means that St. Joan's is accomplishing its goal more quickly than we ever have. For the households who have not yet given, there is still time. Remember, 50 percent of the overage comes back to our parish communities. A gift to the HOPE Appeal is a gift to St. Mary's and St. Joan's. Again, thank you for your tremendous generosity. Mary Immaculate and Saint Joan of Arc, pray for us!
