FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE

Bishop Cunningham will be celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation for all of young people from St. Mary's and St. Joan's this Wednesday, June 5 at 7PM at St. Mary's in Hamilton. All are welcome and encouraged to attend. It will be a joyous celebration for our parish communities, as we celebrate together this special moment in the lives of our young people. What is Confirmation all about? The prophets of the Old Testament foretold that God's Spirit would rest upon the Messiah to sustain his mission. Their prophecy was fulfilled when Jesus the Messiah was conceived by the Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. The Holy Spirit descended on Jesus on the occasion of his baptism by John. Jesus' entire mission occurred in communion with the Spirit. Before he died, Jesus promised that the Spirit would be given to the Apostles and to the entire Church. After his death, he was raised by the Father in the power of the Spirit. The Sacrament of Confirmation deepens our baptismal life that calls us to be missionary witnesses of Jesus Christ in our families, neighborhoods, society, and the world. We receive the message of faith in a deeper and more intensive manner with great emphasis given to the person of Jesus Christ, who asked the Father to give the Holy Spirit to the Church for building up the community in loving service. This Wednesday, we will pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the lives of our young people that they will be bold and courageous witnesses to the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the world.
