I would like everyone to prayerfully consider seeking out the Sacrament of Reconciliation this Lent. A unique opportunity to go to confession this Lenten season will be on Sunday, March 18 at 3pm. St. Mary's will be hosting our Lenten PCA (Pastoral Care Area) Penance Service for the parishes of St. Joan's, St. Bernard's in Waterville, and St. Joseph's in Oriskany Falls. We will have multiple priests available to hear your confessions. If you have been seeking a confessor from outside of our community, please take advantage of this graced event.

I can tell you from my own experience that I have experienced nothing but God's love, mercy, and patience in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. There is nothing that has brought me more peace and consolation in my spiritual life than this sacrament. I am humbled each time I go to confession because every time I confess my sins I am always reminded that God will never abandon me and will never stop loving me. I also relearn each time I seek this great sacrament of mercy that God never tires of forgiving my sins and that he actually takes joy in releasing me from the bonds of sin.

If you have been away from the sacrament for a while or have forgotten how to celebrate the sacrament, have no fear. Any priest will be happy to walk you through it from beginning to end. You don't have to remember anything, but only what you want to share with Jesus in the confessional. The priest will just be happy that you had the courage to take this step closer to the Lord, and he will do everything he can to make your experience of the confessional a good one. So come out on Sunday, March 18 at 3pm and be renewed in a way unlike any other. Mary Immaculate and Saint Joan of Arc, pray for us!
