Remember, going to confession at least once a year is highly encouraged for a Catholic who wants to consider themselves to be "practicing." I like to use the analogy of a yearly physical exam. We may feel everything is ok with our bodies, and then we go to our yearly physical exam and find out something is going on internally and that we need to take care of the issue in a timely manner. The same principle applies to the soul and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We may feel everything is ok with our souls, but then we go to our yearly confession and find out that we need to take some timely steps for greater spiritual health. If you have been away from the sacrament for some time, please do not be afraid. Any one of our priests will be happy to walk you through the sacrament when you arrive.

Important: Fraudulent Text Messages

From the Diocese of Syracuse Office of Communications: please be aware of a text/phone scam involving the use of cell phone numbers with a 315 area code, sent by individuals claiming to be diocesan priests. These fraudulent texts ask for gift cards at amounts of \$500. Text message spam is illegal and is usually an attempt to get the receiver to provide personal information, such as social security numbers or banking information. Here are a few tips to avoid repercussions from text message spam:

- Do not respond to the text message
- Do not click on any links that may be included in the message
- Delete the message
- Add your cell phone number to the National Do Not Call Registry

If you receive a similar spam text message (or phone call) from someone claiming to be a priest of the Diocese of Syracuse, please notify the diocesan Office of Communications at 315-459-7170. We are also aware of similar scam requests sent by email; if you receive an email claiming to be sent by a diocesan priest asking for money or personal information, do not reply and forward the email to stop-fraud@syrдио.org.
