**BISHOP LUCIA HAS SUSPENDED  
ALL PUBLIC MASSES  
IN THE DIOCESE OF SYRACUSE**

*\*All regular gatherings that take place on our church campuses are cancelled until further notice.*

1. **Father Hage will be live streaming the 8am daily Mass as well as the 11am Sunday Mass from his rectory.** He will begin to pray daily Masses Monday through Friday over live stream to encourage people to join him in praying in a more intentional way for an end to this pandemic and that our faith communities remain unharmed. <https://www.facebook.com/StMarysStJoans>
2. **Office hours will continue as usual, but parishioners can no longer drop by the office.** Parishioners are encouraged to communicate with the office over the phone, email, etc.
3. **The church will still remain open during the day for private individual prayer and/or Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.**
4. **Father Hage will be available to hear confessions at St. Mary's from 4pm to 5pm every Saturday.** A temporary confessional will be set up in the church to allow for safe distancing as well as easy sanitizing after each penitent celebrates the Sacrament.
5. **Funerals, Weddings, and Baptisms will still be allowed in the church, but attendance at these celebrations will be limited to immediate family only.**

**Lenten Adult Faith Formation Series Online Course**

Father Jason Hage will be leading parishioners in a weekly online Adult Faith Formation series every Wednesday at 7pm during the season of Lent. We will be covering the book *Eucharist*. In this remarkable book, Bishop Robert Barron offers insights into the mystery of Christ's presence in our lives. As festive as the film *Babette's Feast* and as profound as the work of Ronald Knox, this fresh look at the Eucharist brings to light the meanings of meal, sacrifice, and real presence in our lives.
