FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE

This weekend is HOPE Appeal Weekend! Together, when we pledge our gift to the Annual HOPE Appeal, we are giving thanks to Christ for the innumerable gifts we've been given and helping our friends and neighbors who benefit each year from the diocesan good works funded through our annual appeal. I am asking all parishioners to contribute to this year's HOPE Appeal. If we all give, we will easily meet our 2019 HOPE Appeal goal of \$14,711.97 for St. Mary's and \$6,412.78 for St. Joan's, which is our parish share of the support for HOPE Appeal-funded ministries, programs, and services. If we exceed our target, 50 percent of the excess will be returned directly to our parish communities. We plan to use these funds toward our Evangelization and Outreach programming. However, if we do not meet this goal, the shortfall will be taken from our general fund. **In an effort to meet our goal at St. Mary's in Hamilton, I am asking every St. Mary's family to consider a minimum gift of \$96.00 (averages out to \$8 a month). In an effort to meet our goal at St. Joan's in Morrisville, I am asking every St. Joan's family to consider a minimum gift of \$108.00 (averages out to \$9 a month).** Last year at St. Mary's, 76 households contributed to the HOPE Appeal to help reach our parish goal, which is 47% of St. Mary's registered households. Last year at St. Joan's, 37 households contributed to our parish goal, which is 64% of St. Joan's registered households. This kind of participation is outstanding! If you are able to contribute more, I strongly encourage you to do so. If you are not able to make the minimum gift, please consider any size gift. Your gift, no matter the size, whether it is a pledge or a one-time gift, will make all the difference. Thank you to everyone returning their HOPE Appeal pledge card this weekend! If you are still prayerfully considering your HOPE pledge, you may bring your completed pledge card to Mass next weekend or drop it by the parish office.
