**FROM THE DESK OF FATHER HAGE**

The 56th annual World Day of Prayer for Vocations will be celebrated by the Catholic Church on the Fourth Sunday of Easter, May 12, 2019, a day that is also commonly referred to as Good Shepherd Sunday. Inspired by the Lord's instruction in the Gospels of Matthew 9:38 and Luke 10:2, in which Jesus exhorts the people to "ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest," World Day of Prayer for Vocations unites the faithful together in praying for the fostering of all vocations, particularly those of ordained ministry and consecrated life. Closing his Message for the 2019 World Day of Vocations, Pope Francis beseeched young people to realize that following Jesus is always worth the risk. "Do not be deaf to the Lord's call," he urged. "If he calls you to follow this path, do not pull your oars into the boat, but trust him. Do not yield to fear, which paralyzes us before the great heights to which the Lord points us. Always remember that to those who leave their nets and boats behind, and follow him, the Lord promises the joy of a new life that can fill our hearts and enliven our journey."
