To conclude Vocations Awareness week, I would like to draw our attention to the fact that most young people do not seriously consider a vocation to the priesthood or religious life until they have been personally encouraged to think about it. I think there is a lot of truth in the statement, "If you see something, say something." If you see a young person praying sincerely or serving generously, then ask them if they have ever thought about becoming a priest or a religious sister. This simple question may plant the seed for a genuine vocation to blossom in the years to come. All it takes is one simple inquiry, and then leave the rest up to God. If the call is genuine, then it will bear fruit in God's time. And we can never forget to pray that many more young people will have the courage to respond to God's invitation in their life. Generous hearts are joyous hearts. Mary Immaculate and Saint Joan of Arc, pray for us!

Signs of a Call to Priesthood or Religious Life

- Love of God that manifests itself in a desire to give one's life in service to God's People
- Love of the Church and its rich tradition
- Love of the Sacraments and a desire to celebrate the sacraments with the community
- Love of God's Word and a desire to proclaim the Gospel to God's people
- Desire to model holiness as Christ's representative among the People of God
- A heart that can listen to others and reach out in healing
- Desire to deepen prayer and relationship with God
- Willingness to live simply
- Ability to be happy without the intimate companionship of a wife and family
- Ability to relate with a variety of people, to be happy alone or in a group
- Desire to love expansively rather than needing an intimate relationship with one person
- Joy in serving others in any outreach or parish involvement
- Generosity
- Ability to listen to others and accept direction when needed
- Desire to grow in union with God through prayer and service of the needy
