What a wonderful week we are having here at St. Mary's and St. Joan's! As it says in Psalm 126, "The Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy!" I would like all parishioners to consider taking advantage of two great opportunities this week at Colgate. The Newman Community has invited an internationally known Catholic speaker to present twice on campus this Monday, and all from the parish community are welcome to attend. Massimo Faggioli is full professor in the department of theology and religious studies at Villanova University (Philadelphia) and contributing writer to *Commonweal* magazine. He received his PhD in Religious History from the University of Turin in 2002. His books and articles have been published in eight languages. Here are the two talks he will be delivering on Monday:

This is more of an up-to-the-minute explanation of how the crisis fits into this moment in world history and how it is the most serious crisis in Western Christianity since the Reformation.

Wear Hearing Aids?

For those of you who use hearing aids, you should visit your audiologist or hearing aid dispenser where you ordered your hearing aids to have the T-Coil activated for hearing loops. They will know how to set up a program where you will simply push the button on your hearing aid to activate the T-Coil. Tell them it is important to match the gain curve output of the T-Coil setting to the standard gain curve of your everyday setting.
